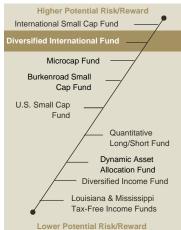

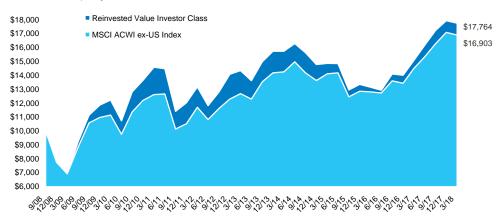
FUND OBJECTIVE
